A meeting of the Sullivan County Board of Health was held. Timely public notice was made by a public posting at the Health Office and by advertisement in the Sullivan Daily Times.

- 1) The meeting was called to order by Dr. Woods after noting the presence of a quorum.
- 2) Approval of <u>minutes</u> from the meeting held 16 March 2023: Motion by Ms. Morgan, Second by Ms. Weathers, all in favor.
- 3) Approval of <u>Claims Vouchers</u>: Claim vouchers were reviewed and approved on Motion by Dr. Reed-Schuessler, Second by Ms. Hale, all in favor.
- 4) Health Performance Report
 - March:
 - \$3,807.27 receipts
 - On-Site Sewage: 2 permits
 - Birth 93, Death 125
 - Foods: 11 inspections
 - 0 Safe Sleep Education Sessions
 - 1 car seat checks
 - PHN: 5 animal bites; 6 Epi; 6 open lead; 0 TB
 - Vaccines: 38 (5 VFC, 14 Vaxcare, 4 317, 5 covid, 10 PPD)

 - School Support Specialist has March/April personal hygiene drive in progress.
 - Immunization trailer was picked up and ready for use. Dates are planned for weekly outings this summer for community outreach and education.
 - Highlighting staff on Facebook for service awareness.

5) Old Business:

- <u>Health Administrator</u>: Discussion ensued regarding hiring options. Plan to hire internally by moving the current food inspector to coordinator role which will include foods. May hire an additional environmentalist as able.
- Storage Building: Await bid plans.
- Governor's Public Health Commission: The legislative session has reached halfway and the bills have moved to the opposite chambers. SB4, HB 1001, 410 IAC 6 are pertinent to local public health departments. Bills are going to conference committee currently.
- On-Site Sewage Violation: Court hearing completed. Judgment order for \$1,000 against Tony Shipman for ordinance violation of 2022-09(7) Permit Process, failure to acquire permit and 2022-09(8)(c)(iii) Installation without certification.
- Vehicle: Silverado 1500 was delivered and decals applied. Title and registration pending.
- <u>Trailer wrap</u>- completed and here for inspection by board.

6) New Business:

- Tornado Damage update: A list of food activities was presented. Thank you notes were sent to
 the vendors who came to assist the community. Septic environmentalist is meeting with
 homeowners as many existing on-site sewage systems were damaged by debris removal and
 the storm. He is currently providing letters for insurance and assisting the soil scientists on
 sampling to expedite replacement systems.
- Annual Report: 2022 Annual Report has been printed and will be distributed. It was reviewed by the Board.
- <u>Coroner Fee</u>: by state statute the coroner fee on death certificates will increase in July 1, 2023 to \$2.50 (currently \$2.25). Plan to keep current fee ordinance in place until additional changes are needed.
- <u>Immunization Supplement Grant</u>: We have been offered an additional \$25,060.32 for an immunization supplement grant. Staff has signed the paperwork to proceed.
- 7) Good of the Order: Board members were asked to check out the new truck and trailer.
- 8) The meeting was adjourned on Motion by Ms. Morgan, Second by Ms. Pounds, all in favor.
