

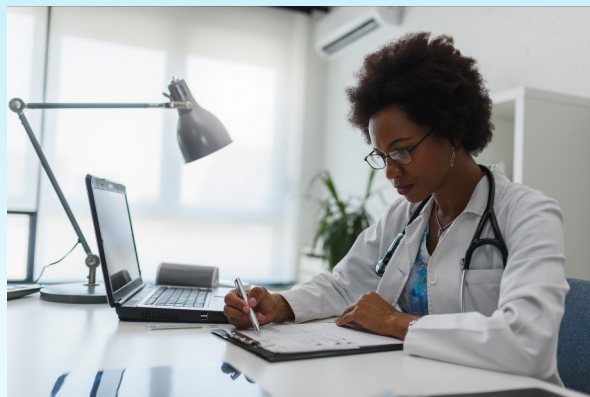

IHCP provides guidance on AssessmentPro PASRR and LOC request requirements

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) wants to remind AssessmentPro authorized users to ensure patient information is accurate before submitting the Level I Preadmission Screening and Resident Review (PASRR) and level-of-care (LOC) assessment to Maximus Ascend. Providers include hospitals, Area Agencies on Aging (AAAs) and nursing facilities (NFs).

The healthcare professional submitting the Level I PASSR and LOC assessment are required to attest that the information is accurate to the best of their knowledge. The submitter accepts full responsibility for submitted content. It is important that the submitter only use a patient's IHCP Member ID (IHCP Medicaid number also known as RID) when submitting their request. Submitters should never use any other patient ID except the Member ID. Failing to do so can jeopardize timely turnaround for PASRR and LOC decisions.
