IHCP removes coverage for voxelotor (Oxbryta)

Effective immediately, for dates of service (DOS) on or after Oct. 2, 2024, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) pharmacy benefit will no longer reimburse claims for voxelotor (Oxbryta).

On Sept. 26, 2024, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) published an alert about the voluntary withdrawal of Oxbryta from the market by the drug's manufacturer, Pfizer Inc. In the FDA alert, the manufacturer recommends, "Health care professionals should stop prescribing Oxbryta. Patients and caregivers should contact their health care professional about stopping Oxbryta and starting another treatment option."



Carve out

Oxbryta has been carved out from managed care, which means that prior authorization (PA) and claims were processed through the fee-for-service (FFS) pharmacy benefit administrator, Optum Rx, for all IHCP members.
