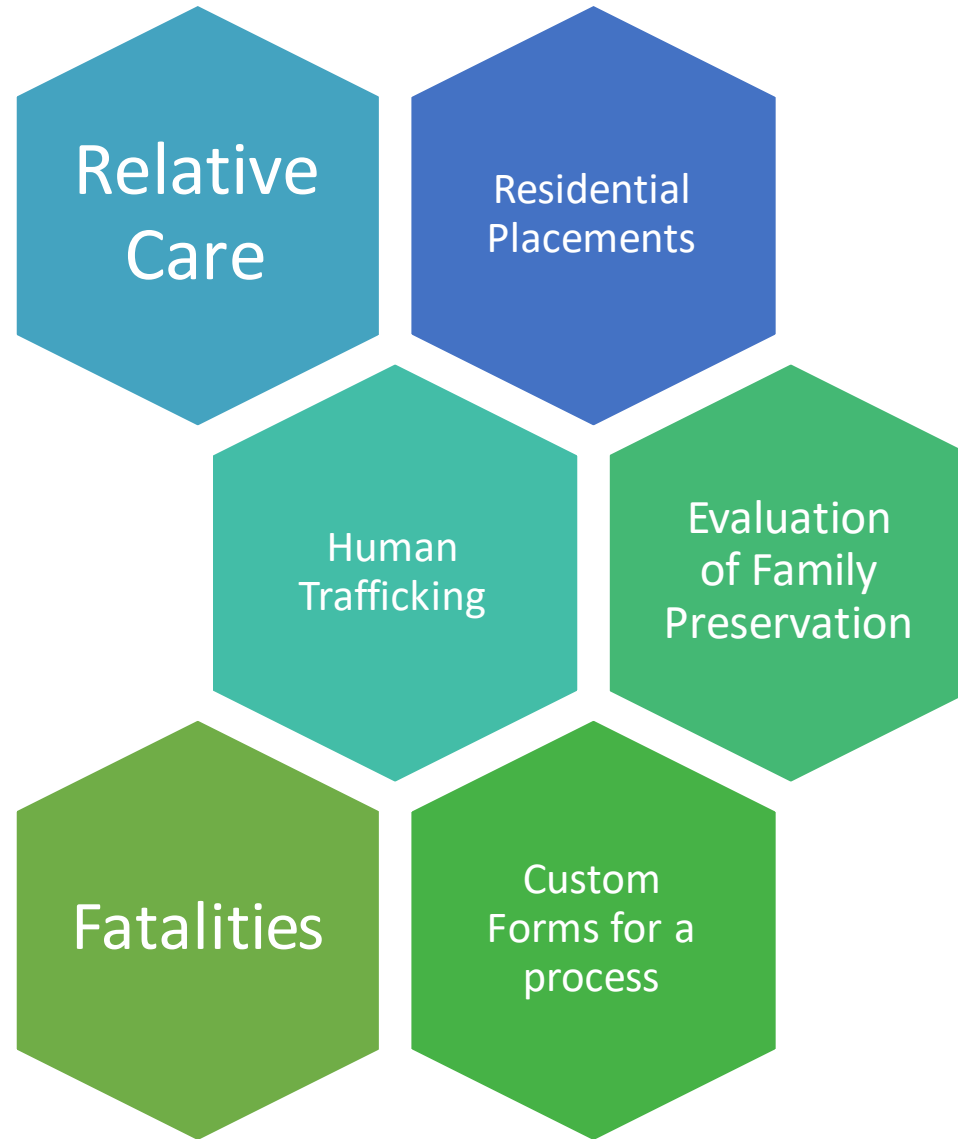

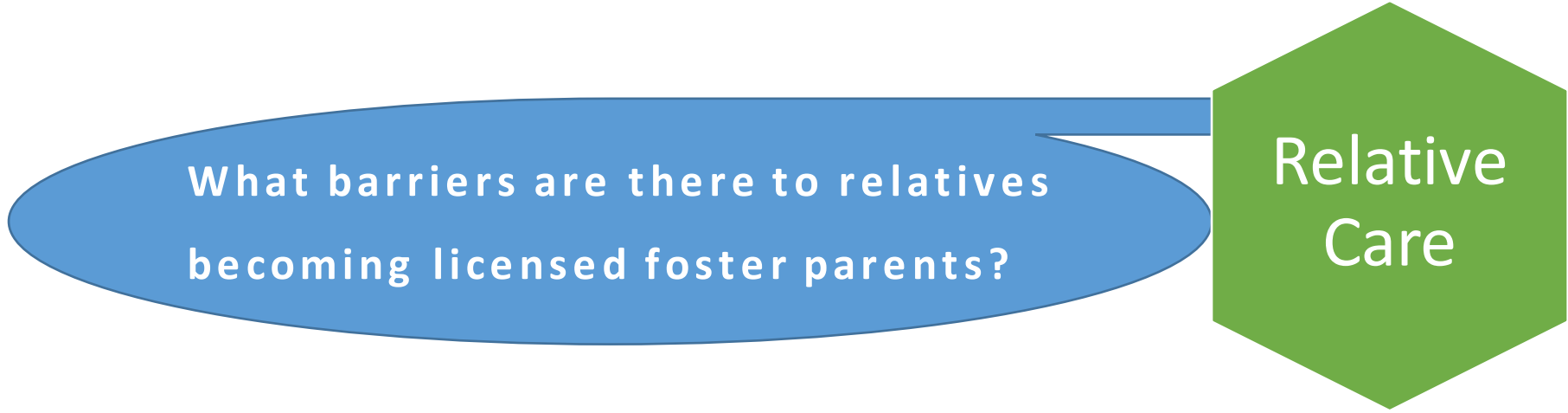

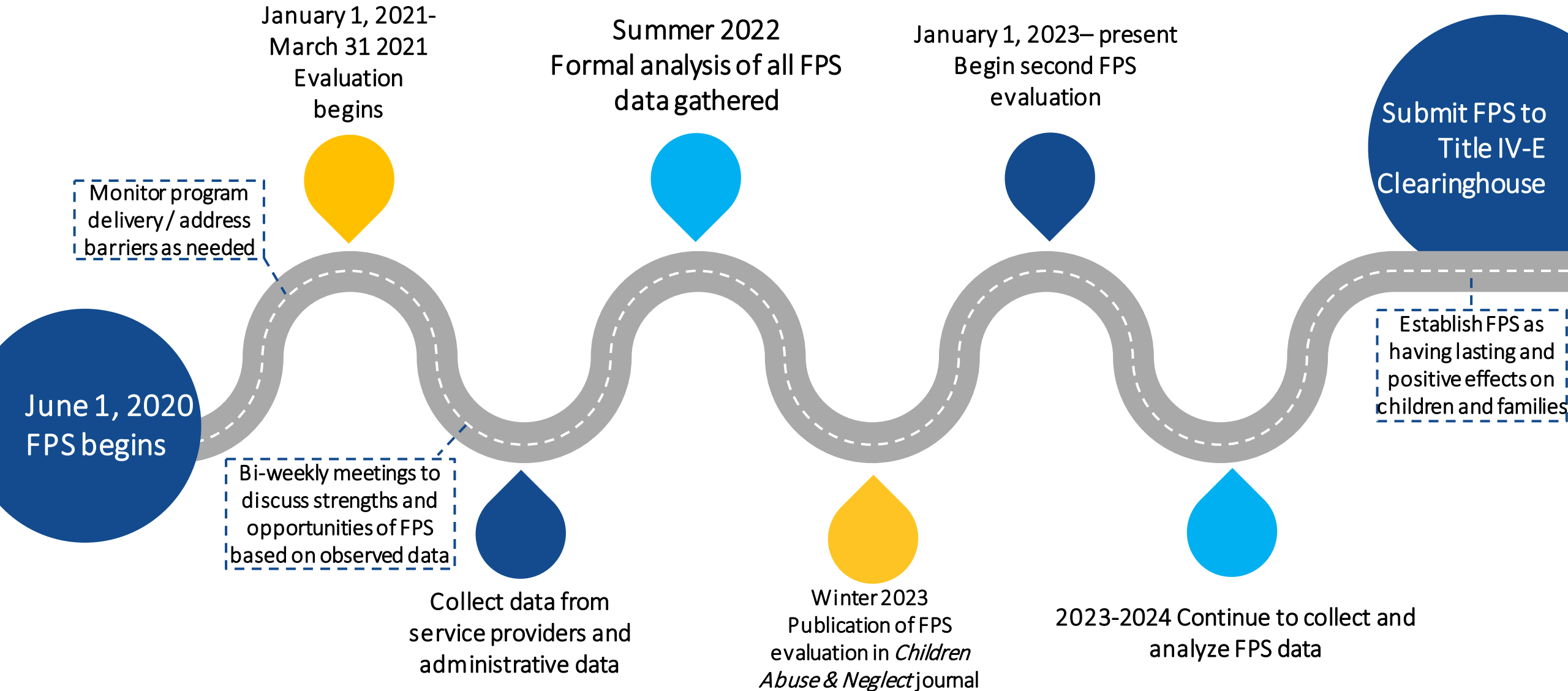

Evaluation of Family Preservation Services (FPS)

Quantitative Analyses

- **Data Sources:**
 - Administrative Data
 - Provider survey
- **Methodology:**
 - Track outcomes for approximately 1,000 families referred to FPS
 - Use data to determine if program is operating according to FPS service standard
 - Determine if FPS has positive effects on children/families

Qualitative Analyses

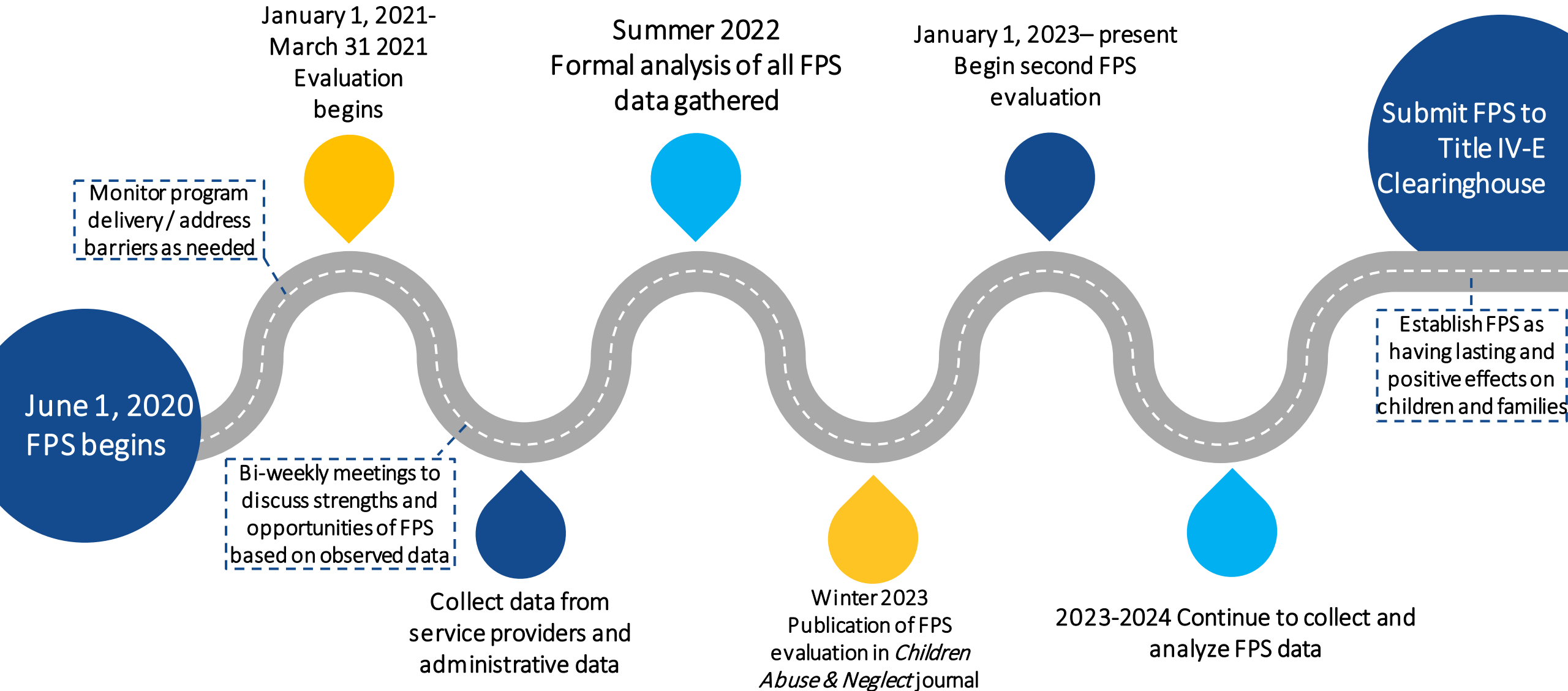
- **Data Sources:**
 - Service Provider Interviews
 - Caseworker Survey
 - Caseworker Interviews
- **Methodology:**
 - Understand the perspectives of service providers and caseworkers on FPS
 - Code individual responses to identify trends and themes regarding FPS

Evaluation of Family Preservation Services (FPS)

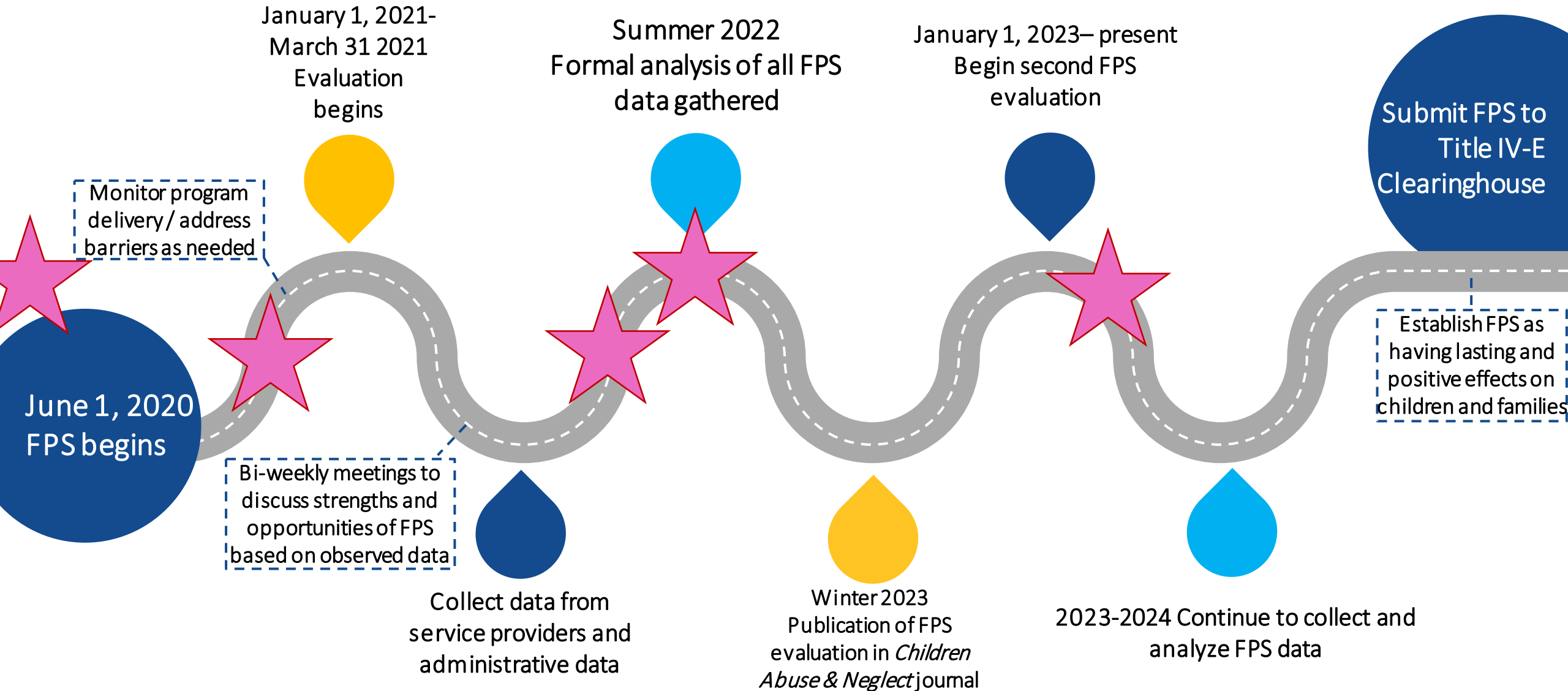
Future Steps of the FPS Evaluation

- Integrate state-wide Medicaid data with existing data
- Establish a new evaluation population that focuses on children/families that have had no prior involvement with DCS
- Ongoing interviews with Providers, FCM's, and Families through an existing (and evergreen) improvement process

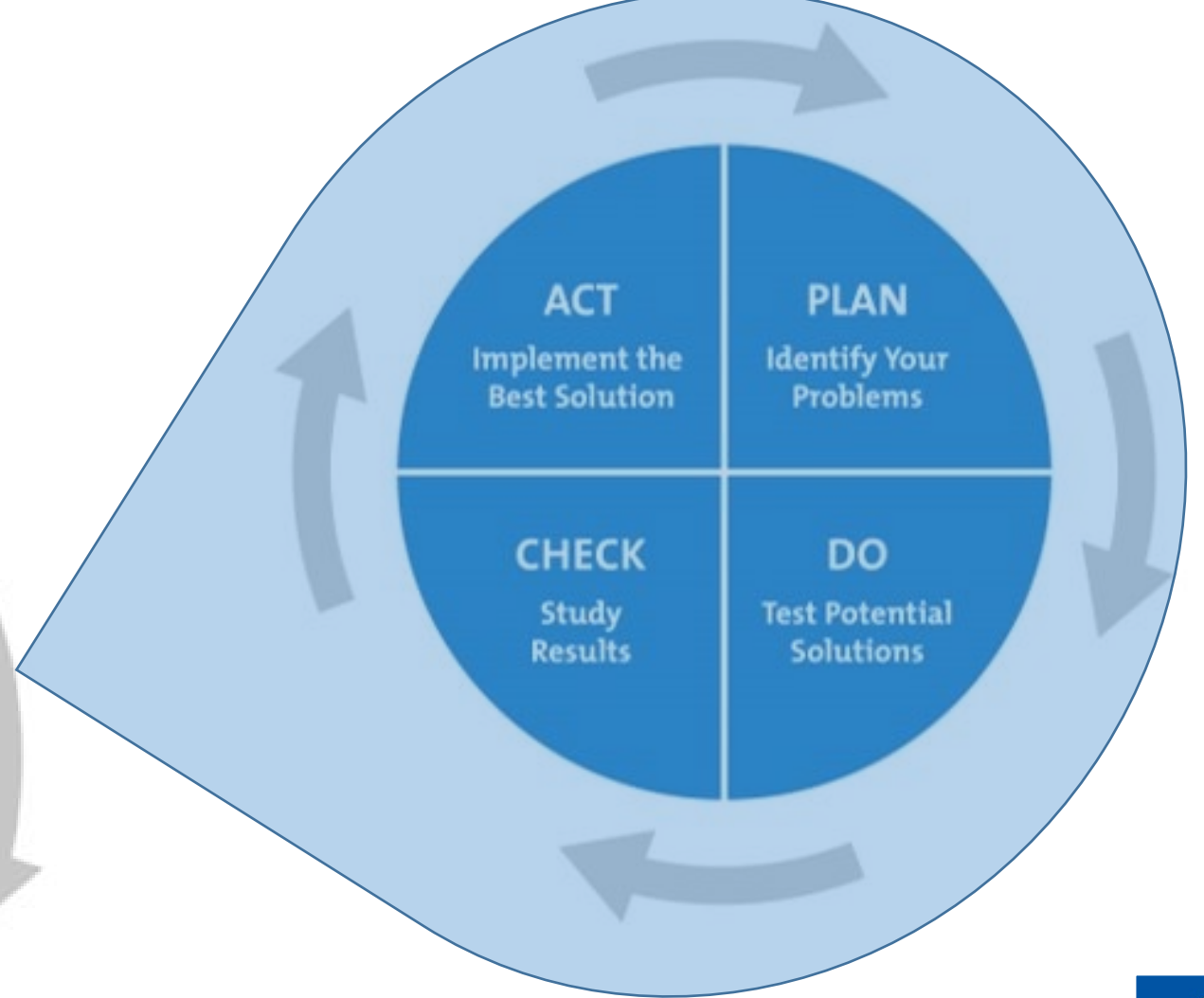
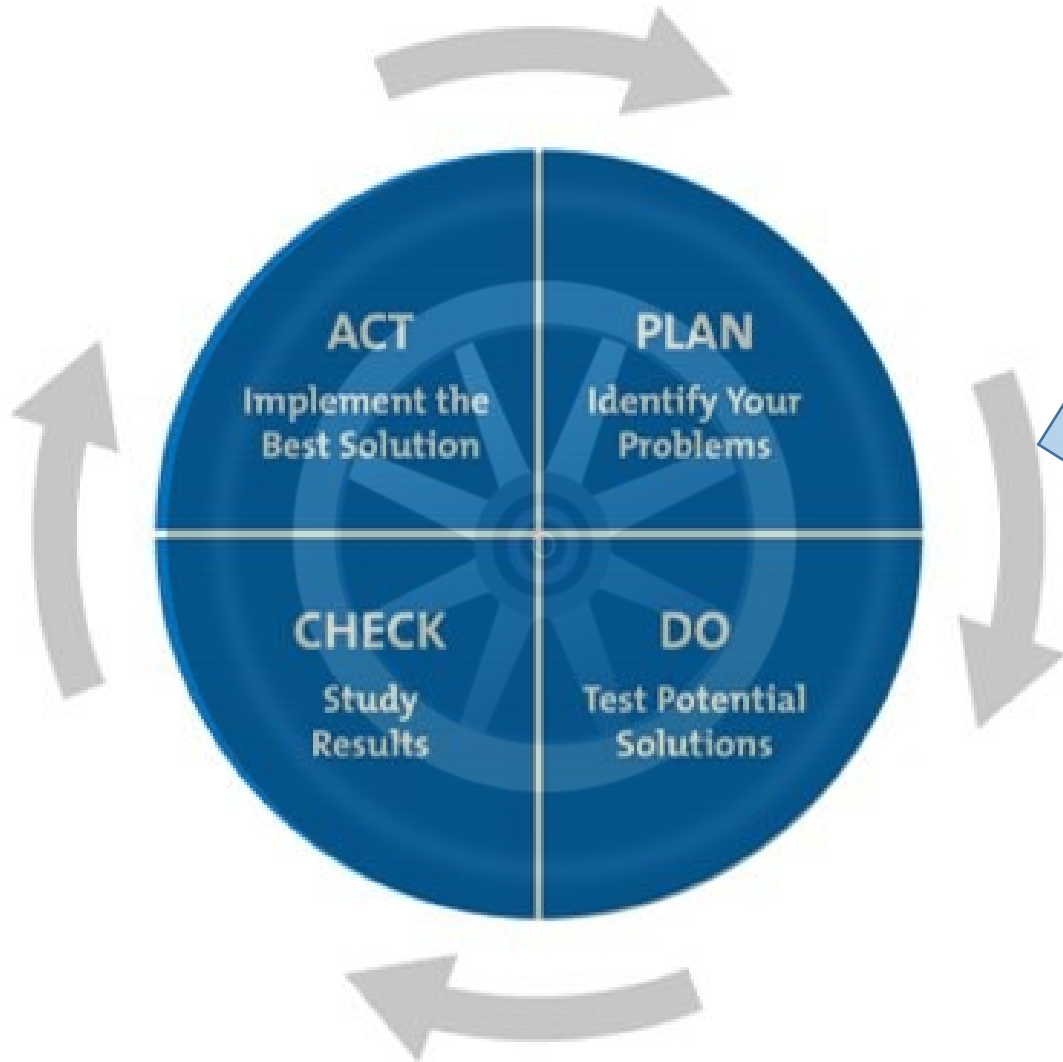
