

**TITLE 312 NATURAL RESOURCES COMMISSION****Legislative Notice for Rule Readoption**  
LSA Document #24-574

Under [IC 4-22-2.6-3](#), the Natural Resources Commission notifies the Legislative Council of its intent to readopt rules in anticipation of rules expiring January 1, 2026.

**SUBJECT MATTER:** The readoption of rules concerning: (1) definitions applicable to [312 IAC](#); (2) navigable waters; (3) trails and scenic rivers; (4) law enforcement employed by the department of natural resources; (5) protection and management of fish and wildlife; (6) dams; (7) surface water dispute mediation; (8) timber buyers, their agents, and growers; (9) forest and resource management; (10) petroleum; (11) the protection and management of entomology and plant pathology; (12) historic preservation; (13) archaeology; (14) human remains, burial objects, and artifacts; and (15) coal mining. The repeal of rules concerning: (1) duplicative fees that appear in other articles of the Indiana Administrative Code; (2) an unnecessary provision regarding geese; and (3) the state land office.
