



RECOVERY HOUSING PROGRAM

PURPOSE

The Recovery Housing Program provides funding to support stable, transitional housing for individuals in recovery from a substance use disorder.

ELIGIBILITY

- Lead applicant must be an entitlement city, non-entitlement city, county or incorporated town that possesses the legal capacity to carry out the proposed program.
- The lead applicant may contract with a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization to carry out the activities of an eligible project, provided that the organization can document its nonprofit status with the U.S. Internal Revenue Service, the Indiana Department of Revenue and the Indiana Secretary of State.
- The following activity is eligible for RHP funding this round:
 - Public facilities and improvements.
- RHP eligible projects:
 - Must use funds for the acquisition, rehabilitation, or construction of recovery residences that will meet level II, III, or IV National Alliance of Recovery Residences standards.
 - Maximum of 8% of the grant for grant administration.

FUNDING DETAILS

- The maximum grant allocation is **\$750,000**.
- No local match required.
- Open CDBG grants limit has been waived.
- \$5,000 cap per beneficiary has been waived.
