Office of Energy Development continues series of public meetings on home energy rebates; Fort Wayne is June 25; Virtual closeout session is June 27

INDIANAPOLIS -- The Indiana Office of Energy Development (OED) is wrapping up a series of public meetings as key elements of a comprehensive planning, design, and implementation process for a federally funded home energy rebate program. The final in-person session will take place in Fort Wayne on **Tuesday**, **June 25** and the final meeting, a virtual closeout session, is scheduled for **Thursday**, **June 27** (meeting information below).

Public engagement is a critical component of the rebate development process, and OED is requesting robust input from the public and an array of stakeholders. The initial phase of the process—developing the state's detailed implementation plans—is underway and will continue through mid-summer.
