# c. Practice Ruling Question 1.

I am writing regarding some clarification questions regarding the Indiana Practice Act for occupational therapists as there seems to be some ambiguity in the type of modalities allowed in practice. According to the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (NBCOT), dry needling (DN) is recognized as a physical agent modality (PAM) within the scope of practice for an Occupational Therapist with demonstrated competence within the Occupational Therapy Code of Ethics (OTCOE) stating, "AOTA asserts that interventions to support occupations including but not limited to physical agent modalities (PAMs), dry needling, and other techniques may be used in preparation for, or concurrently with occupations and activities or interventions that ultimately enhance a client's engagement in occupation". However, the Indiana regulations are not clear on whether or not this PAM can be used in practice and what requirements or stipulations exist around using DN. IC 2523.5-1-6.5 states " Application of physical agent modalities and use of a range of specific therapeutic procedures used in preparation for or concurrently with purposeful and occupation based activities, including techniques to enhance sensorymotor, perceptual, and cognitive processing, manual therapy techniques, and adjunctive and preparatory activities for occupational performance. However, manual therapy does not include spinal manipulation, spinal adjustment, or grade 5 mobilization." Can you please provide clarification on the exact views of the board regarding using DN in OT practice within the state of IN? Is there additional certification needed to demonstrate competency for DN or any other PAMs? Additionally, regarding private practice clients, what is the requirement for initial evaluations? Is there a need for an MD order, or is it at the discretion of the treating therapist to determine a plan of care and the need for a full evaluation based on an initial screening?
