The ALJ recommended reinstatement of Respondent's license free and clear. Mitigating factor: Indiana suspension was based exclusively on Kentucky discipline and Respondent's license has already been reinstated on probation (2021) and withdrawn from probation (2024) there. She has already successfully completed the probationary component of her Kentucky discipline order. She intentionally waited for the probation to be withdrawn in Kentucky to petition for reinstatement of her Indiana license, even though it was not required by the terms of her Indiana order. She could have petitioned for reinstatement in 2021, when her Kentucky license was restored to a probationary status.
