2. Pathways to Licensure

Jason Shelley wanted to make the Board aware of the possibility of creating a pathway to licensure without the aspect of formal education. NCARB is conducting a study about different pathways to become licensed, for example, by experience without education. There are 17 states that do not require a NAB accredited degree. Indiana does not require a NAB accredited degree if people apply via reciprocity and have been licensed at least seven years and in good standing. More AXP is how NCARB is leaning as well. Jason Shelley also is working with AIA on this. Jason, Deb and Hal will work on this for the September meeting. More required experience would balance out in lieu of a NAB degree. This would apply to landscape architects as well.

3. NCARB ABM REPORT – Todd Scoggins/Hal Kovert

Hal reported about the ABM. The main resolution was about regional realignment. Many states were not in favor of this measure. The resolution did not pass, so the regions stay as they have been. The origination of this resolution was from the NCARB Board of Directors. There were two new at large Board of Directors elected. Next year's ABM is in Scottsdale.

4. CLARB ABM

The ABM is in Buffalo this year. This year the meeting is in combination with the ASLA Licensure Summit, so it is a weeklong meeting. Deb Schmucker and Todd Scoggins will attend the CLARB ABM meeting.
