





Tobacco Free Recovery Grants Project Overview

Tobacco dependence treatment is often left out of mental health treatment plans, even though people with mental health disorders are among the heaviest users of tobacco according to the CDC. The tobacco industry has historically preyed on individuals with mental health or substance use disorders and as a result, commercial tobacco use prevalence remains significantly higher among individuals with behavioral health conditions and substance use disorders.



The Tobacco Free Recovery Grants has a 3-Tiered approach to address this issue:

- Tobacco Free Grounds Policies
- Tobacco Treatment
- Integrating Quit Now Indiana into EHR Systems















Quit Rate and Satisfaction

Research shows that only 4–7% of people who use tobacco who try to quit smoking on their own are successful.

Behavioral Health Program - 32% quit rate & 84% satisfaction rate **Pregnancy Program -** 63.5% quit rate & 79% satisfaction rate
