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About Handle with Care


The *Handle with Care* program enables law enforcement to send a confidential notification to a child's school when they have been at the scene of a potentially traumatic event, providing a "headsup" to the school to allow them to provide trauma-sensitive support.



First responders encounter a child/children at a scene, notify school. Schools respond with traumasensitive support for child/children involved.

Mental health providers partner with schools.





- 2013: Piloted in WV
- 2015: Statewide in WV WV State Police
- **2020:** Becomes an IDOH-led initiative
- 2021: Piloted in Richmond Community Schools
- Current efforts: Expansion across state
 - 17 counties, 41 school districts
 - 25 counties interested or planning
