



- Connections to 911 and 988
- Multi-Disciplinary Team: Case Manager, Master's Level Clinician, Peer Support Professional







- He was found walking around a cemetery

- Engaged with him and listened
- Upon assessment determined he was not safe
- He agreed to go with team for an inpatient hospitalization


