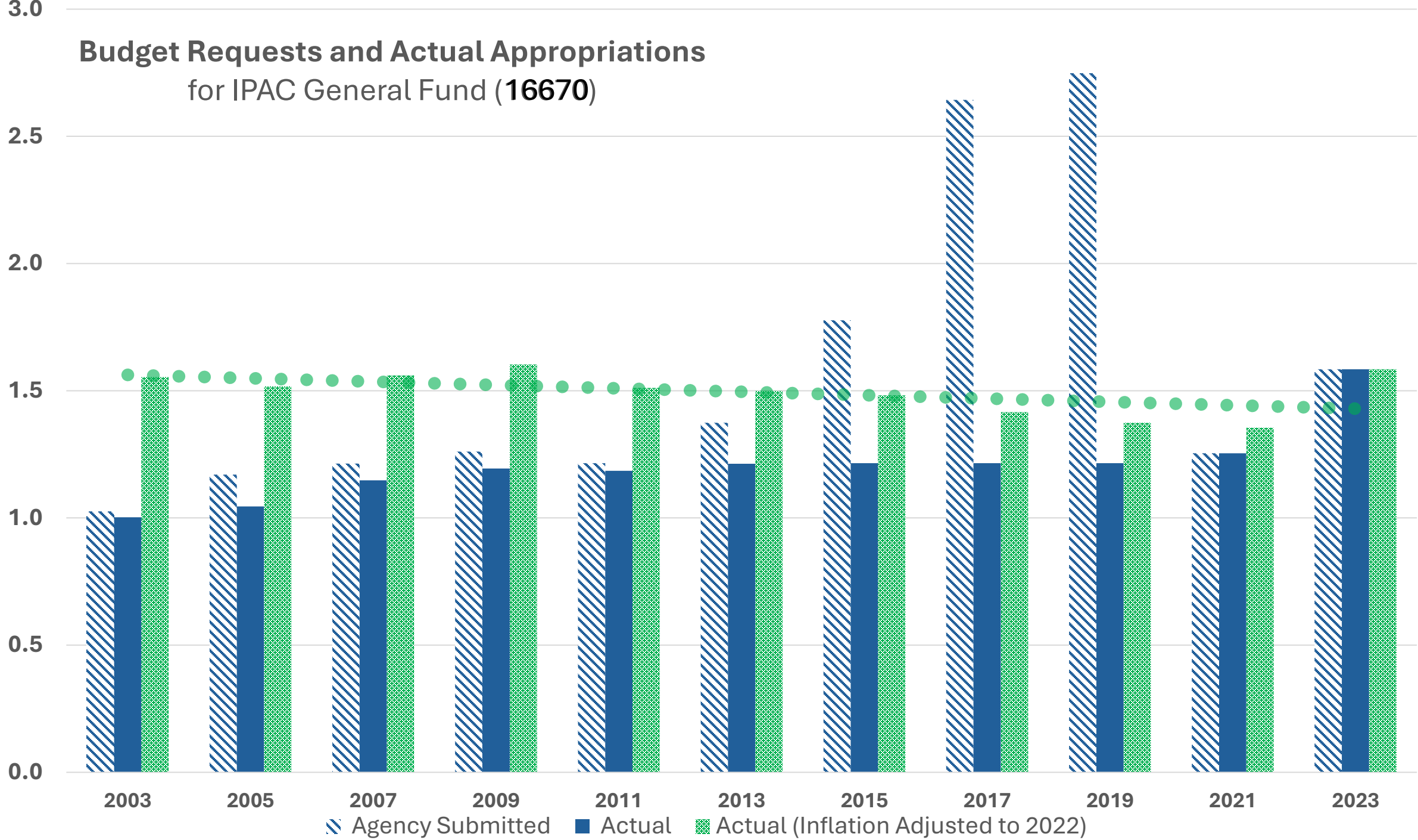

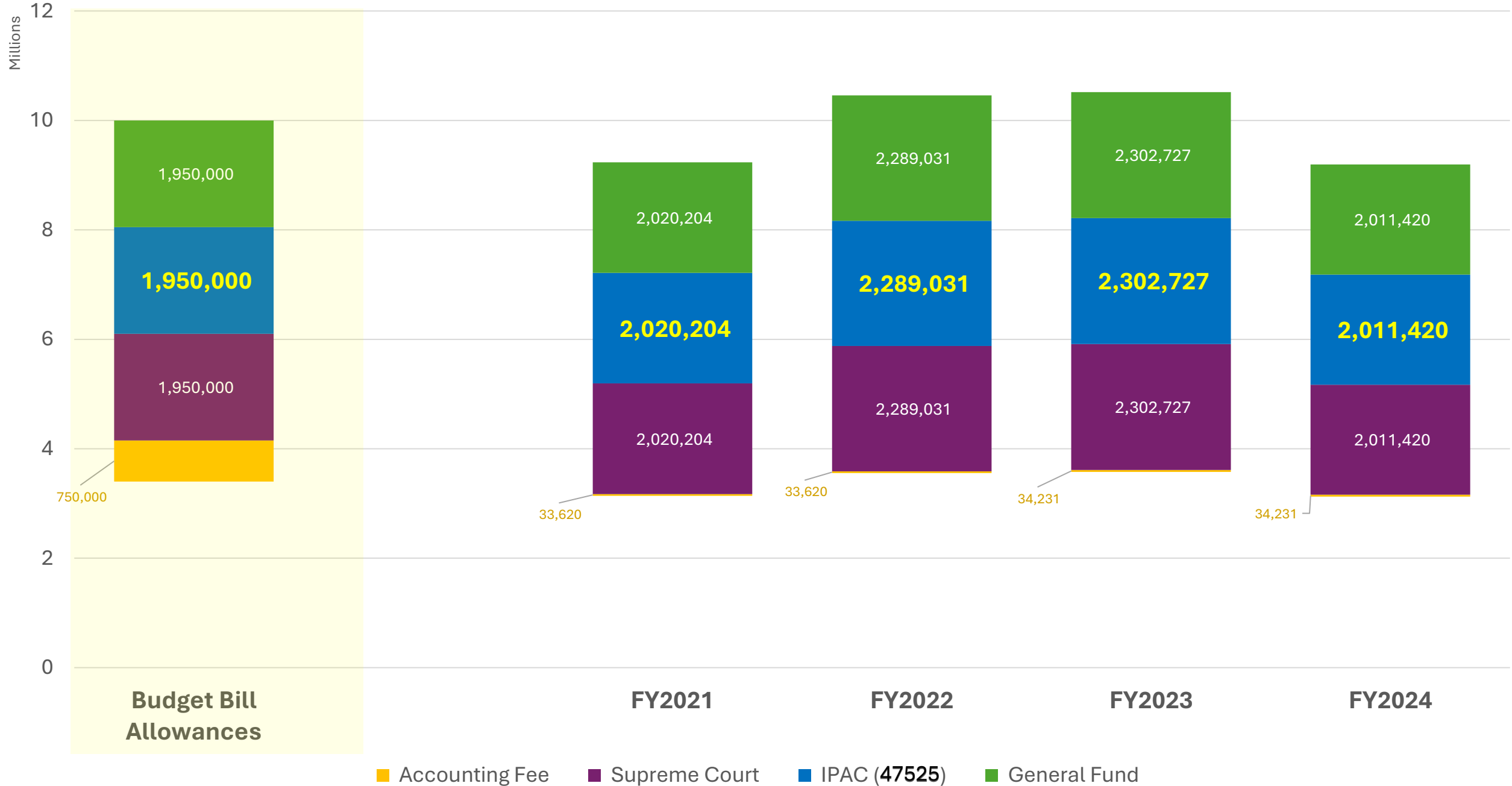

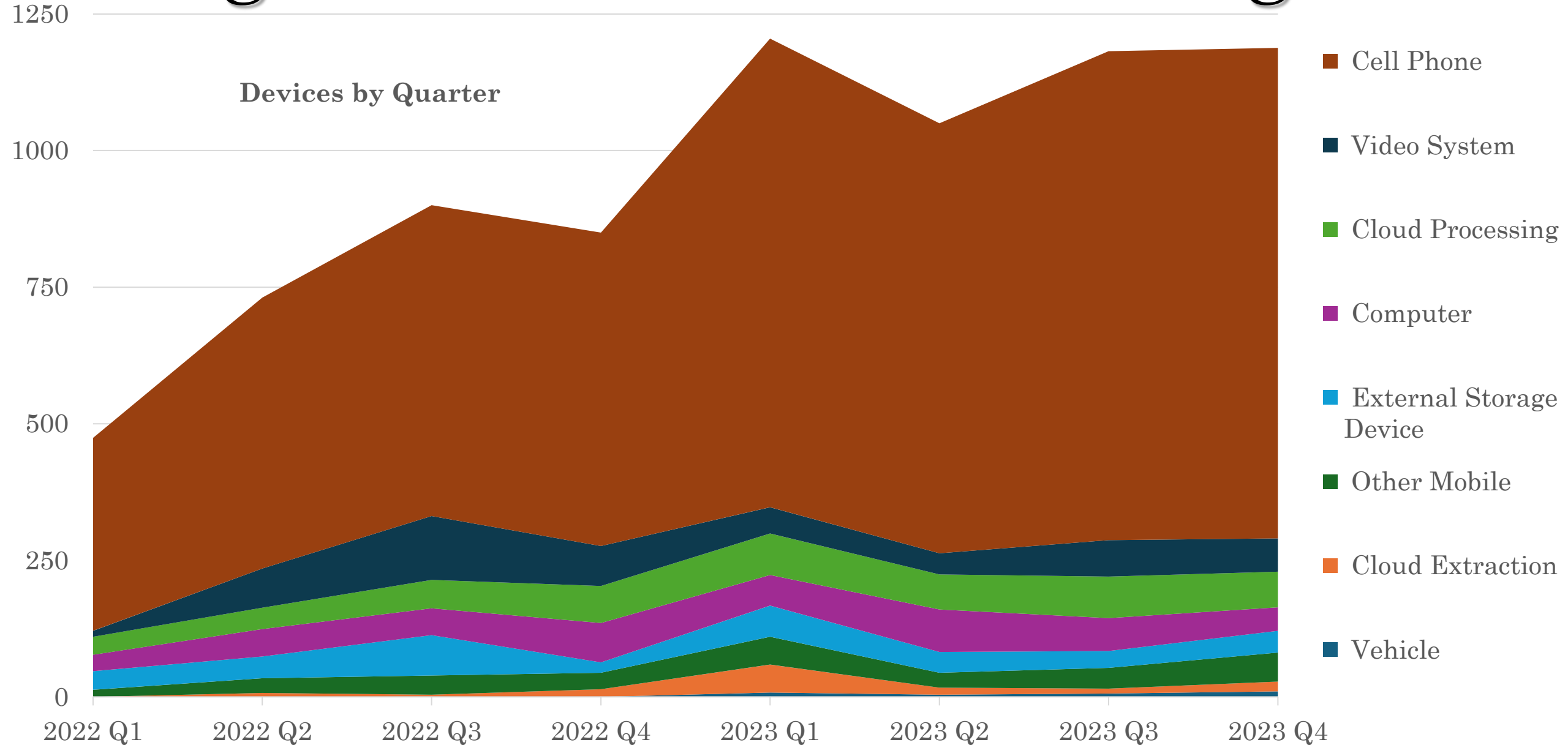


IV-D Cost Recovery Distribution Analysis

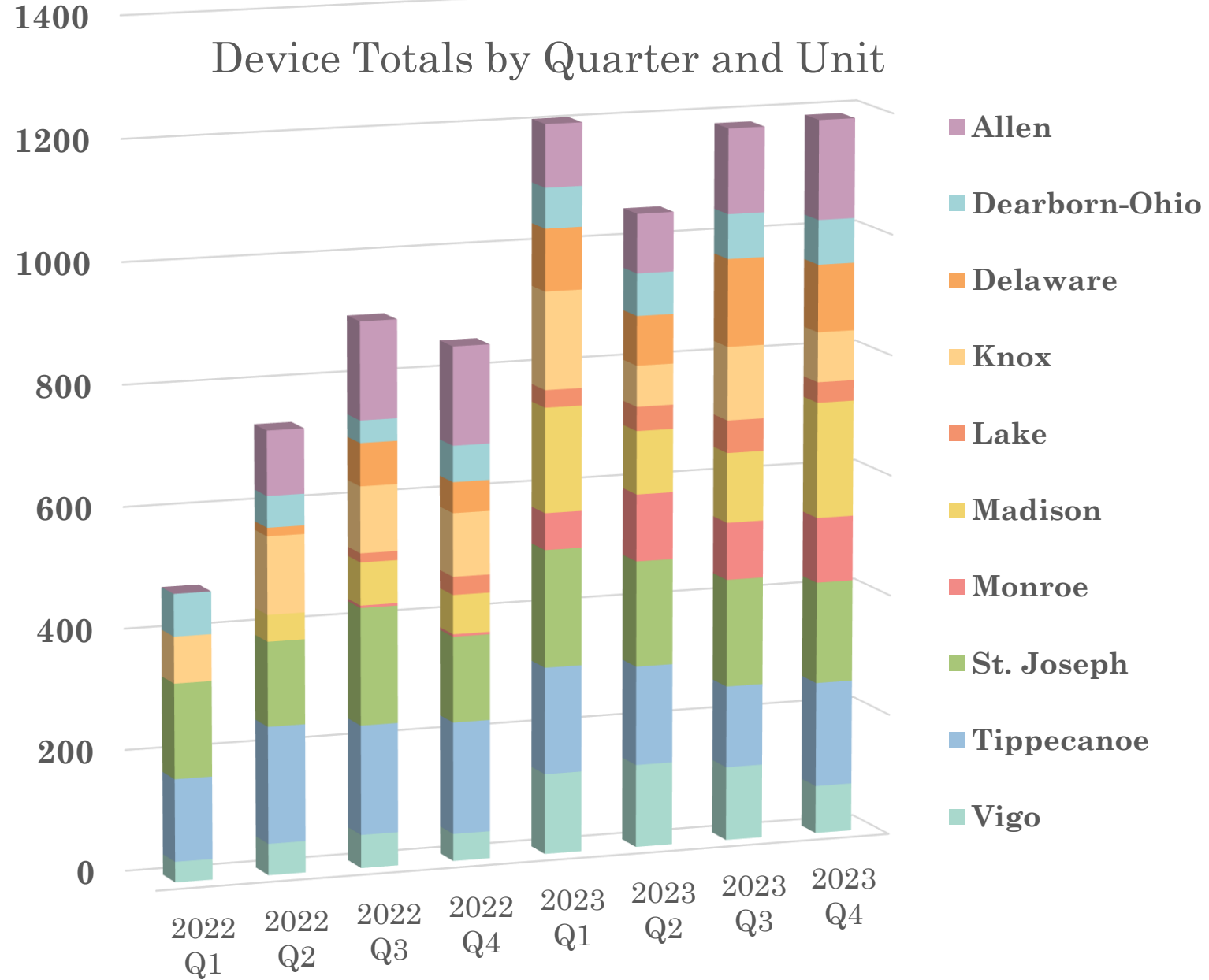
Devices by Quarter



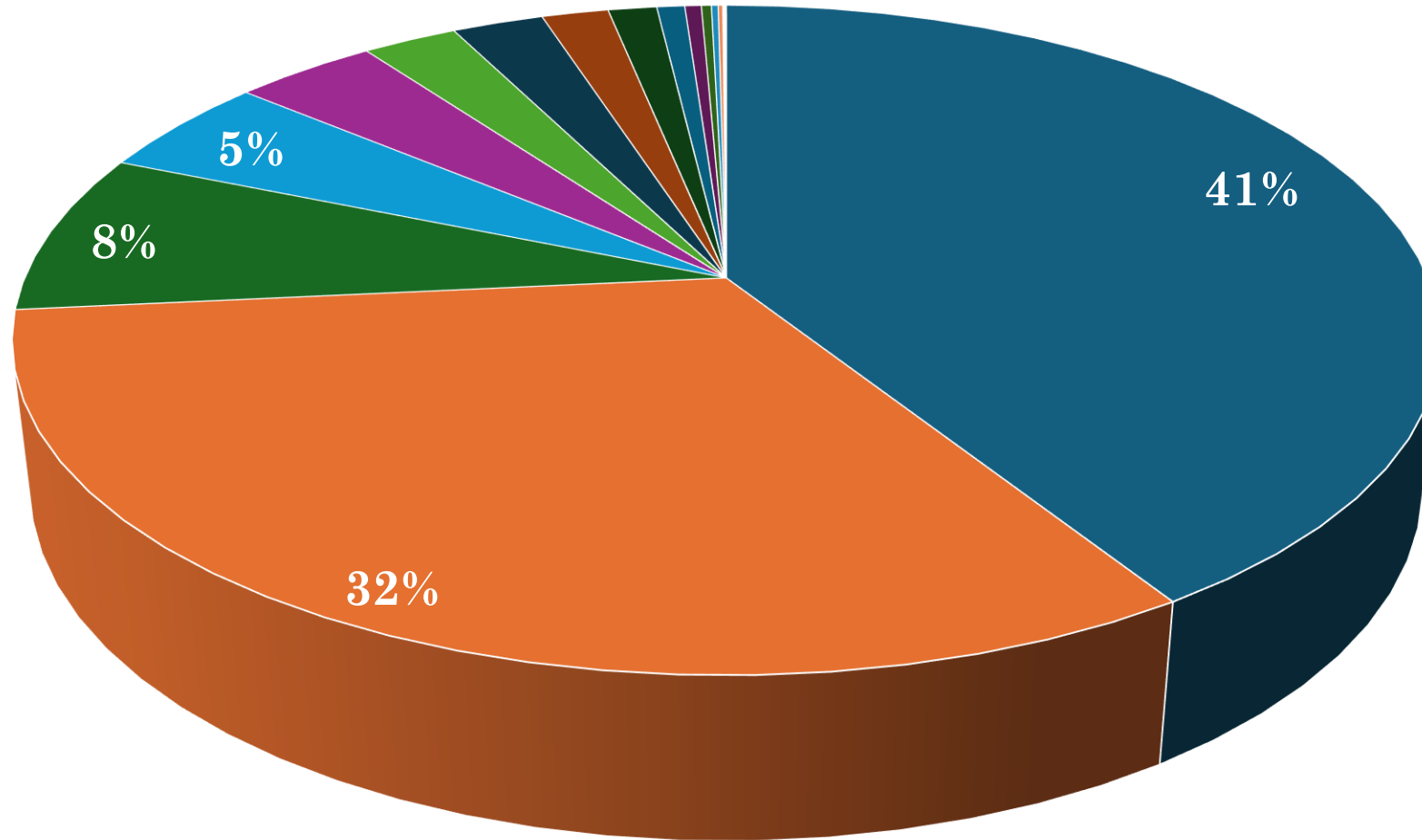
High-Tech Crimes Unit Program

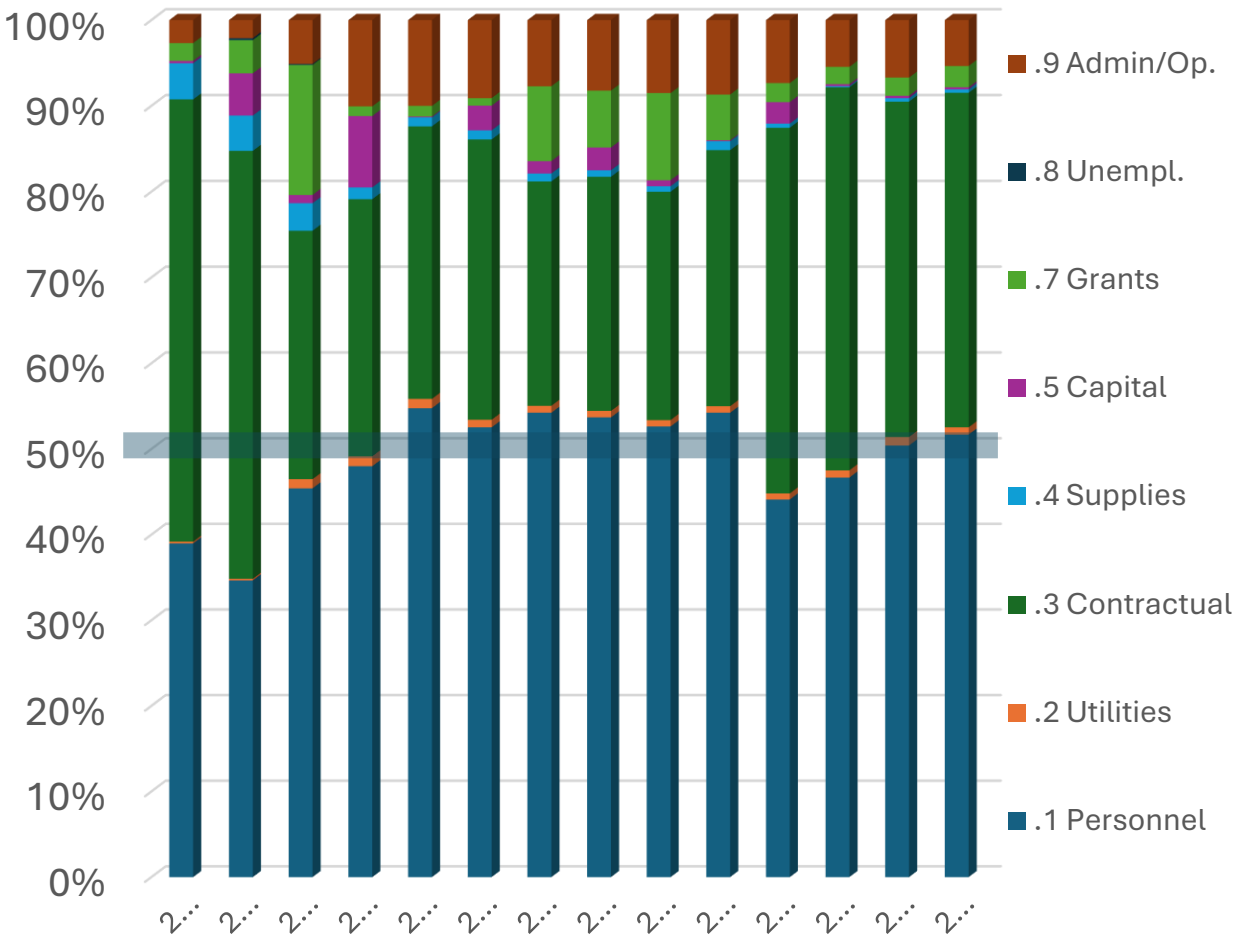

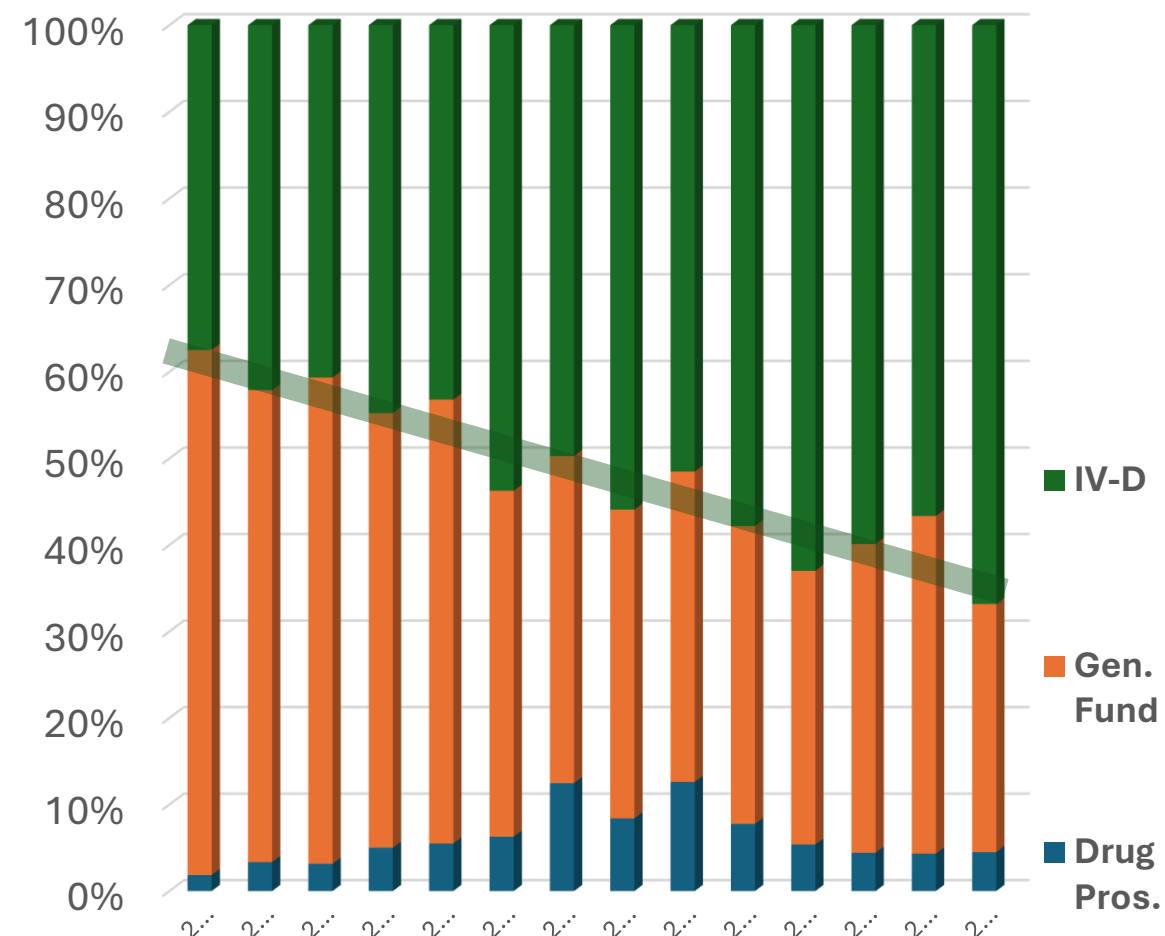

Points as Share of FY Expenses

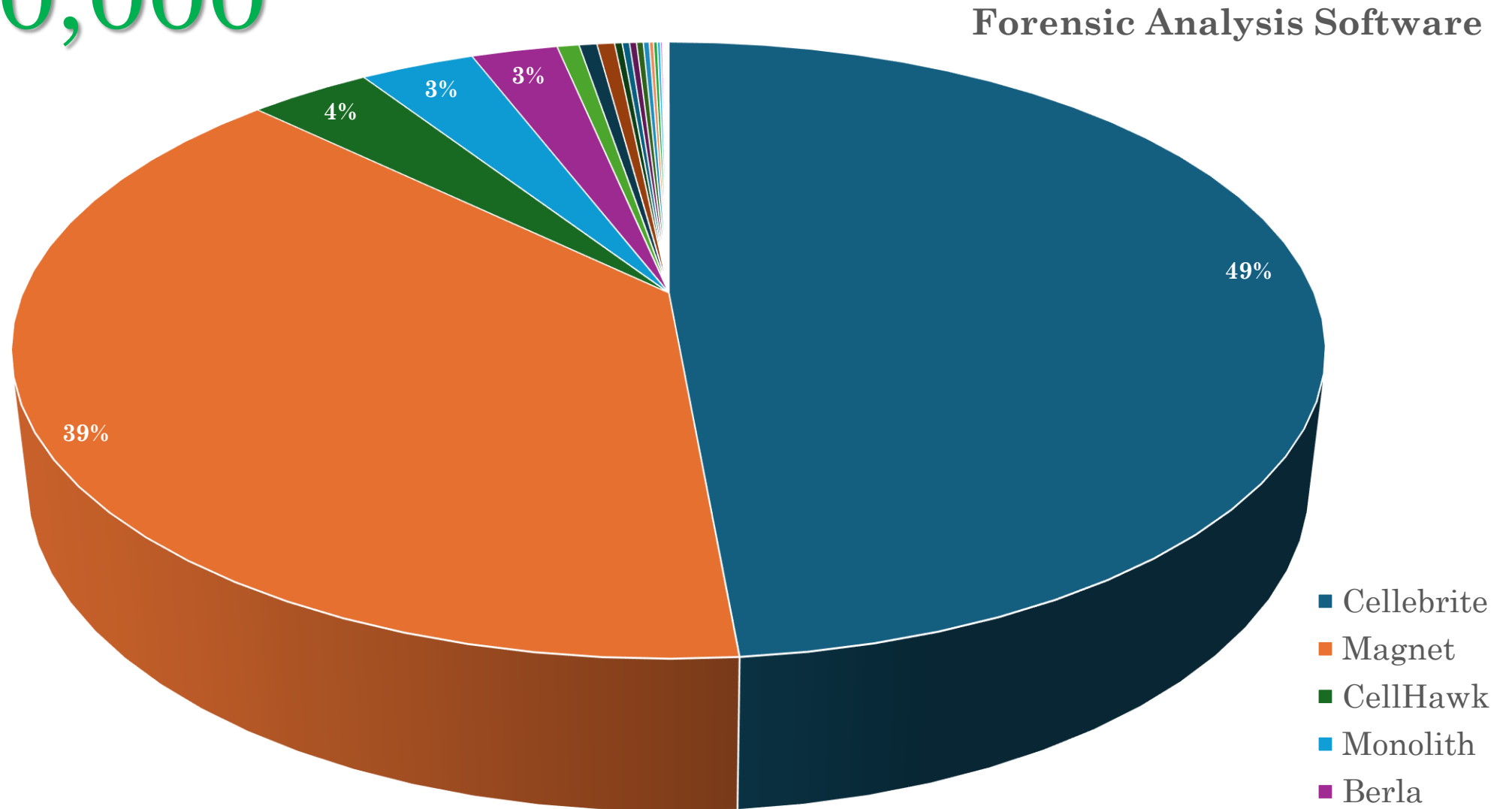


Funds by Share of Total FY Expenses
