

- A concentrated focus on helping students successfully transition to ISU through workshops, co-academic advising, and community events makes the pathway to blue a reality.













Statewide Economic Impact







### **Line-Item Requests**

# Indiana Principal Leadership Institute -- \$600,000

Created by the General Assembly in 2013 to build leadership capacity among state's public school principals.

### DegreeLink -- \$446,438

Created by the General Assembly in mid-1990's to enhance remote learning to place-bound citizens in priority professions.

### Building Nursing Capacity -- \$204,000

Created by the General Assembly in 2007 to increase capacity in the nursing field














