Subject: New Educator Preparation Provider – Road2Teach

Road2Teach is a newly developed transition to teaching program proposal designed for Indiana's elementary and secondary educator preparation. The program was created to provide a new, online, asynchronous educator preparation opportunity for those already holding a bachelor's degree or higher and seeking an elementary or secondary license. As a reminder, transition to teaching is the only option allowing an entity other than an institution of higher education to offer a program for educator licensure (511 IAC 10.1-3-7, Sec. 7, (a)).

The Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) recommends that the Indiana State Board of Education grant approval to the following new educator preparation provider (EPP) for a limited period of three years:

Road2Teach - Indiana Educator Preparation Provider

IDOE will continue to monitor the progress of the above program by reviewing all annual state and federal reports required of them, including candidate performance data. Beginning in spring 2025 the department will conduct an annual review of this program and will recommend renewal or nonrenewal after the third year. Road2Teach will also be included in reviews required of all Indiana EPPs, including those related to science of reading, alignment to standards, national accreditation, etc.
