POLICY ASSIGNMENT OF DEALER LICENSE NUMBERS

General

Indiana Code § 9-32-11-6 allows a dealer to change their business name or location. Indiana Code § 9-32-11-15 allows a dealer to, among other things, change the form of organization, state of incorporation, and ownership.

The Secretary, through the Auto Dealer Services Division ("Division"), administers and enforces Indiana Code § 9-32, Title 75 of the Indiana Administrative Code, and the policies and procedures of the Division.

Policy Statement

A. It shall be the policy of the Division to allow a licensed dealer to maintain their dealer license number in the following situations, provided all applications, requests, and/or other required documentation are timely completed and submitted:

- 1. Change in business name or address.
- 2. Change in business organization or entity, if the change does not involve a material fact in the financial condition of the dealer.
- B. It shall be the policy of the Division to assign a new dealer license number in the following situations:
 - 1. Change in business organization or entity that involves a material fact in the financial condition of the dealer.
 - 2. Complete change in ownership.
 - 3. Change in license type.
 - 4. Any other situation in which the Division, in its discretion, determines a new dealer license number is appropriate.
