#### **Emergency phone:**

Please do not call the after hours emergency phone with billing questions. The person answering the phone does not have access to your account information. The phone is <u>ON-LY</u> for utility emergencies such as power outages or water leaks.

#### Meter System Upgrade:

The Town is in the process of changing meter reading sys-

- NO PAINT
- NO BATTERIES
- NO LOOSE BRUSH PILES
- NO CEMENT
- NO HEAVY APPLIANCES SUCH AS WASHING MACHINES, DRYERS, REFRIGERATORS, HOT WATER HEAT-ERS
- NO CARCASES
- NO LARGE PIECES OF METAL

ITEMS THAT CAN BE PICKED: MATTRESSES, BROKEN DOWN SATELLITE DISHES, TVs, COMPUTERS AND RE-CLINERS.

HEAVY TRASH DAY IS AN ADDITIONAL TRASH DAY DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR. PICK UP WILL RUN FROM 8-10AM, SATURDAY APRIL 24, 2021. ITEMS, SUCH AS BRUSH, NEED TO BE BAGGED. IN ADDITION, ANY-THING THAT HAS A LOT OF LOOSE PIECES NEEDS TO BE BAGGED. THE TRUCKS **WILL NOT** GO DOWN ALLIES. ALL TRASH NEEDS TO BE CURBSIDE, JUST LIKE A NORMAL TRASH PICK-UP DAY. THE TRUCK **WILL NOT** CIRCLE BACK IF YOU FORGET TO PLACE YOUR ITEMS BY THE CURB, AND THEY WILL NOT COME UP TO YOUR DOOR TO GET ITEMS.

ANY ITEMS LEFT BEHIND, THE TRASH SERVICE WAS UNABLE TO TAKE.
