When you arrive please be aware of your surroundings and watch for instructions. Please do not block streets and/or intersections. Be safe and courteous.

### Reach Alert:

As of 03/15/2023, approximately 90% of our customers had been added to the alert system. If you would like your account information (sign-in and password) so you can change your account settings and set your preferences, please contact Carla at the utility office.

The service is free, although messaging and data rates may apply depending on your carrier and service plan. If you prefer to not get texts or calls, you can choose to get your alerts via email instead.

### Utility Payments:

Please be sure when you are writing checks to pay utility bills that you are using either blue or black ink and double check to make sure you have filled in all fields correctly.

If you are placing a cash payment in the drop box, please be sure it is contained in some fashion (paper-clipped, taped, bagged, enveloped...) We would not want to get anything mixed up and applied to the wrong account in error.

### Utility Issues:

If you have issues with the functionality of any of your Advance Utilities (electric/water/septic), please contact the office directly during business hours at 765-676-6611. If it is not an emergency leave a message on the office line. For emergencies after hours, call 765-978-1007.

- **NO CEMENT**
- **NO HEAVY APPLIANCES SUCH AS WASHING MACHINES, DRYERS, REFRIGERATORS, HOT WATER HEATERS**
- **NO CARCASES**
- **NO LARGE PIECES OF METAL**

ITEMS THAT CAN BE PICKED: MATTRESSES, BROKEN DOWN SATELLITE DISHES, TVs, COMPUTERS AND RECLINERS.

HEAVY TRASH DAY IS AN ADDITIONAL TRASH DAY DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR. PICK UP WILL RUN FROM 8-10AM, SATURDAY APRIL 29, 2023. ITEMS, SUCH AS BRUSH, NEED TO BE BAGGED. IN ADDITION, ANYTHING THAT HAS A LOT OF LOOSE PIECES NEEDS TO BE BAGGED. THE TRUCKS **WILL NOT** GO DOWN ALLIES. ALL TRASH NEEDS TO BE CURBSIDE, JUST LIKE A NORMAL TRASH PICK-UP DAY. THE TRUCK **WILL NOT** CIRCLE BACK IF YOU FORGET TO PLACE YOUR ITEMS BY THE CURB, AND THEY WILL NOT COME UP TO YOUR DOOR TO GET ITEMS.

ANY ITEMS LEFT BEHIND, THE TRASH SERVICE WAS UNABLE TO TAKE.
