Did You Know?:

The calendar on the Town's website has all of the billing due dates, what date and time each month that late fees will be applied, and what date and time each month disconnects will occur.

If improvements or changes to your property are being done, please perform your due diligence before work begins.; i.e., obtaining proper permits, line locates - 811, verification with Boone County APC and surveying. You can research your own GIS mapping (property lines) on the county website

If you feel there is a discrepancy with the mapping, you would need to have a survey done to verify property lines.

Sprinkler Meters:

In order to receive sewer credit for filling pools and watering lawns/gardens, you must have a sprinkler meter. We will take a reading in the spring, and a reading in the fall; a credit will be applied for the entire season after the second reading.

Sprinkler meters and adapters are available for purchase in the Town Hall. The cost of the meter is \$80 This is not a rental fee, the meter will be yours to keep upon purchase.

Advance Food Distribution:

The drive thru food pantry located at the Advance Volunteer Fire Dept - 106 E Wall St is held the 3rd Tuesday of each month from 4PM to 5:30PM. This is available for all Boone County residents or those that live within a 10 mile radius of Advance. When you arrive please be aware of your surroundings and watch for instructions. Please do not block streets and/or intersections. Be safe and courteous.
