

Reach Alert:

Visit www.reachalert.com to sign up for the Town's text alert system. If you need assistance with this, please contact us in the office. We send notices regarding outages, information about Town meetings, office closings, and other issues as they arise. We can also send the 24 hour disconnect notices this way instead of taping a letter to your door.

We do not bombard you with frivolous messages. The service is free, although messaging and data rates may apply depending on your carrier and service plan. If you prefer to not get texts or calls, you can choose to get your alerts via email instead.
