Sprinkler Meters:

In order to receive sewer credit for filling pools and watering lawns/gardens, you must have a sprinkler meter. We will take a reading in the spring, and a reading in the fall; a credit will be applied for the entire season after the second reading.

Sprinkler meters and adapters are available for purchase in the Town Hall. The cost of the meter is \$80 This is not a rental fee, the meter will be yours to keep upon purchase.
