Advance Food Distribution:

The drive thru food pantry located at the Advance Volunteer Fire Dept - 106 E Wall St is held the 3rd Tuesday of each month from 4PM to 5:30PM. This is available for all Boone County residents or those that live within a 10 mile radius of Advance. When you arrive please be aware of your surroundings and watch for instructions. Please do not block streets and/or intersections. Be safe and courteous.

Sprinkler Meters:

Reminder: if you plan on using Town water to fill a pool or routinely water your lawn/flowers/ garden during the warm months; you can receive credit for the sewage that would typically be charged on the gallons of water used during the season. In order to receive this credit you would need to have a sprinkler meter and report the beginning and ending usage to the utility office. We do have sprinkler meters available for purchase at the Town Hall for \$80.00

Rate Reduction:

Legislation was passed this spring which removes the Indiana Utility Receipt Tax (IURT) of 1.4% from Electric and Water Utility bills. This reduction is effective July 1st 2022. This will automatically be reflected on your bills when it goes active.
