Advance Food Distribution:

The drive thru food pantry located at the Advance Volunteer Fire Dept - 106 E Wall St is held the 3rd Tuesday of each month from 4PM to 5PM. This is available for all Boone County residents. When you arrive please be aware of your surroundings and watch for instructions. Please do not block streets and/or intersections. Be safe and courteous.

Reach Alert:

If you have not already signed up for ReachAlert, we will be adding you to our system if we have an active phone number or email address attached to your account. This will allow us to communicate with you more effectively and in a more timely manner. If you would like to specify which phone number or email address you receive these alerts to, please contact the office so we can note your preferences.

We do not bombard you with frivolous messages. The service is free, although messaging and data rates may apply depending on your carrier and service plan. If you prefer to not get texts or calls, you can choose to get your alerts via email instead.

Utility Payments:

Please be sure when you are writing checks to pay utility bills that you are using either blue or black ink and double check to make sure you have filled in all fields correctly.

If you are placing cash payments in the drop box, please be sure it is contained in some fashion (paper-clipped, taped, folded, enveloped...) There are some days that there are quite a few payments in the box and we would not want to get anything mixed up and applied to the wrong account in error.

Daylight Savings:

When you change the times on your clocks, make sure to check the batteries and/or dates for your smoke detectors and test them to make sure they work. If you need working smoke detectors, please contact the Advance Volunteer Fire Department, they may have some at no cost to you.
