Effective county-wide 06/01/2019; All pets are required to either have properly registered microchips or have a permanent tag affixed to a durable collar with owner's name, address, and phone number to aid in quick identification and contact of proper owner.

The owner will be responsible for all fines and/or fees if a loose pet is picked up by Animal Control or the Humane Society.
