ORDINANCE NO. 2018- 01

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A HYDRANT METER
AND USE POLICY**

WHEREAS, on occasion, developers, contractors and the general public may need to access and use water from the Town of Advance for a particular, limited purpose; and

WHEREAS, in these instances, the Town Council of the Town of Advance deems it would be proper to assign a hydrant meter to each of these users in order to accurately track and bill the water that the user is using for their particular purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Advance deems it necessary to adopt a policy which outlines the procedures by which developers, contractors and the general public for a limited, particular purpose may gain access to water hydrants and hydrant meters.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Advance, Indiana, that the following documents, attached hereto in six pages as Exhibit A and made a part hereof, are hereby adopted by the Town of Advance as the Town of Advance Hydrant Meter and Use Policy and procedures:

- Hydrant-Meter and Use Policy
- Hydrant Policy – Hydrant & Bulk Water Use Agreement
- Town of Advance Utility Hydrant Application

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.




