## GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 2, 2009

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 7, 2006

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of LaFontaine, Indiana, wishes to amend General Ordinance No. 7, 2006, by further restricting open burning within the town limits of the Town of LaFontaine; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of LaFontaine, Indiana, hereby declares that all open burning, except campfires, is a nuisance under General Ordinance No. 7, 2006.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LAFONTAINE, INDIANA, that Section 1 A 3 be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1 A 3. Disagreeable or obnoxious odors and stenches as well as the conditions, substances or other causes which give rise to the emission or generation of those stenches; such as burning in barrels, burning tree leaves that generate air contaminates or grass. Any open burning, except the use of campfires as herein defined shall be considered as disagreeable or an obnoxious odor and stench and are prohibited under this ordinance."

For the purposes of this ordinance, a campfire is defined as an area not larger than four (4) feet in diameter into which only non treated wooded products derived from trees may be burned. The burning of wood products, which have been altered from the original state shall not be burned.
