MEETING MINUTES

Town Council President John Perrin opened the meeting at 5:00 p.m. with the pledge to the American flag. The council has received a request from the WCHS Basketball Coach to reserve the basketball courts in East Park for a 3 on 3 League. The dates for the league would be July 7th, 8th, 12th and 19th from 5 - 9 p.m. for any high school students. Council has no objections but asks Attorney Robbins to draft some type of agreement for consideration at the next meeting. Agreement would be conditioned on adult supervision at all times. Councilman Schilawski states this is being coordinated by the Athletic Department and there would be adult supervision. There is also some discussion about a rental fee and a refundable damage deposit. This item will be placed on the next agenda. Motion to prepare a contract / agreement by Councilman Waltz and seconded by Councilman Vaughn. **Vote 5 affirmative.**




Being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 5:27 p.m.
