Ray Hicks has requested the fence be repaired, and a safety bag on first base. Bruce will put a park bench at the playground. Brian & Shirley Powell at 225 W Walnut St. want to put up a privacy fence on their property, Board has agreed as long as they follow the guidelines from the County Plan Commission for height requirements, etc. Stan Wilson has contacted the probation officer in Wabash concerning the curfew and what to do with the ones breaking it. Bruce will need to buy chlorine tablets for the treatment plant which will cost about \$212.00 board has agreed to this. Bruce will be taking classes for his Wastewater Treatment Certification starting on Aug 21, and ending in Nov with the test on Nov 17. The next meeting will be on Aug 21, 1995 7 p.m. in the basement of the Library, when the budget for 1996 will be signed. The next regular board meeting will be Sept. 11, 1995. Meeting adjourned at 8:10 p.m.
