They also have a problem with cars not yielding at the Ohio St. corner, Valerie suggested the Yield sign be made into a stop sign, Board will take under advisement. Clarence Keppel is negotiating the purchase of Building at the corner of Allen & Church St. for a lawn mower repair shop and had gone to plan commissioner and was told it was already zoned business. The board told him they would be happy to have another business in town. Valerie made the motion to accept New Customer list document to be given to new residents when paying the meter deposit, Larry 2nd carried 3-0.
