### I. Call to Order

- e) Kristina Lynn stated she is working on the amendment for the Abandon and Junk Vehicle Ordinance to merge the Town of Roann Abandon and Junk Vehicle Ordinance with State Statutes. After some discussion, Kristina Lynn will draft the amended Abandon and Junk Vehicle Ordinance for the Town of Roann.
- f) Tony Janeway reported Duke Energy will take care of trimming the trees from the power lines in the alley at 335 South Washington Street.
- g) Robert "M" Ferguson Jr. stated he made numerous calls in regards to restoring the brick and tuck point on the Town Hall building and has received a couple contacts for an estimate this week.

- a) James Pell brought to the Council's attention the flag at the Log Cabin is in need of replacement and the tree needs trimmed. James Pell will follow up with purchasing a nylon flag for the Town of Roann at the Log Cabin. Tony Janeway will follow up with trimming the tree at the Log Cabin.
- b) James Pell questioned if the town is selling the GMC Leaf Truck and Leaf Vac. Tony Janeway will follow up on the value of the Leaf Truck and Leaf Vac and bring to the Town Council at the next Board Meeting for an acceptable price to sell each item.
- c) Tony Janeway stated Leaf pick up will end December 1, 2020.
- d) Robert "M" Ferguson Jr. stated Dave Schuler donated the painting by D. VanBuskirk in the early 1900's to the Town of Roann.
