

RESOLUTION #1-2002

A Resolution to Make a Grant Application to the Indiana Department of Environmental Management

Town of Roann

Whereas, Town of Roann, Indiana, is a municipal corporation and has paid for services of a nature requiring specified equipment; and

Whereas, the specified equipment, CHIPPER, is needed to improve the services provided; and

Whereas, the Town of Roann, Indiana will provide such services, using town employees, and desires to begin a municipal service; and

Whereas, it is finding of fact of the Town Board of Roann following a public hearing that the municipal services provided will promote the public health, welfare, and safety of the residents of the Town of Roann and the Board further determines through careful review and evaluation of all comments that pursuit of an IDEM grant as contemplated hereby, will not significantly displace any private sector services of comparable scope and size, and, most importantly, will assist the state of Indiana in achieving its waste reduction goal of fifty percent by the year 2002.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Town Board, the Town of Roann, Indiana, that:

- 1. The board hereby authorizes the preparation and submittal of an application for an Indiana Department of Environmental (IDEM) recycling program grant to support the recycling of yard waste program of the Town of Roann, Indiana; and
- 2. The Town of Roann commits the requisite matching funds towards the purchase of the Chipper in an amount up to Seven Thousand, seven hundred, fifty-eight dollars and fifty cents (\$7,758.50).

 Commitment of these funds is contingent upon receipt of the IDEM Grant funding.
