

**ORDINANCE # 7, 2022**

**MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ORDINANCE**

**WHEREAS**, IC 3-8-5-2, provides that a town with a population of less than 3,500 that is not located within Marion County, Indiana may adopt an ordinance to provide for the nomination of Democratic and Republican party candidates in a primary election; and

**WHEREAS**, if such an ordinance is adopted, then the county election board conducts the primary election for the town according to the statutes governing primary elections for cities and large towns; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to I.C. 3-8-5-2(e), a Municipal Primary Ordinance must remain in effect for a twelve year period; and


**WHEREAS**, the next municipal primary election is to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in May in the odd-numbered year after the non-presidential (mid-term) federal election (May 2023); and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board believes that it is in the best interests of the Town of Roann and its citizens to adopt a Municipal Primary Ordinance for the Wabash County Election Board to conduct primary elections on behalf of the Town of Roann; and


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town Board of the Town of Roann, Indiana that:

1. For the municipal primary election, there shall be a nomination of Democratic and Republican candidates pursuant to I.C. 3-8-5-2.
2. As such, the Wabash County Election Board shall conduct the primary elections for the Town of Roann.
3. This Ordinance shall remain in effect through December 31, 2034.
4. The Town Clerk-Treasurer shall file a copy of this Ordinance with the office of the Wabash Circuit Court Clerk no later than noon on January 1, 2023.


