

**PRELIMINARY SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT RESOLUTION**

**No. 2000-1**

WHEREAS, it is necessary to improve the following described real estate in the following described manner:

Construct concrete sidewalks in Roann, Indiana, at various locations throughout the Town in cooperation with the property owner and in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in the Office of the Clerk-Treasurer, available by mail at P.O. Box 276, Roann, Indiana.

WHEREAS, upon application and petition by the various property owners, the Roann Town Board will determine estimated costs for the improvements at the respective locations in accordance with the responsibility the Town assumes.

WHEREAS, upon application and petition of the property owners to the Town Board to make said improvements and a determination by the Town Board that it is in the public interest and safety for the Town to participate with the property owners to construct said improvements, a portion of the cost thereof shall be the responsibility of the property owners and a portion of the cost shall be the responsibility of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that it is necessary to improve the following described real estate in the manner described below:

Construct concrete sidewalks in Roann, Indiana, at various locations as applied and petitioned by the respective property owners pursuant to the plans and specifications on file in the Office of the Clerk-Treasurer which are hereby adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the concrete materials used in the improvements of the sidewalks, as constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications as

approved by the Town Board, shall be the responsibility of the Town of Roann. All cost for additional materials and labor in excess of the concrete materials supplied by the Town shall be the responsibility of the petitioner. The Town shall evaluate road repairs which may be necessary as a result of considered petitions and approve as funds are available and in the best interests of the Town, in the Board's discretion.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any petitions approved shall be acted upon within one (1) year of the date the petition is submitted. At the expiration of one (1) year, the petition shall lapse and must be resubmitted.
