STARTING MARCH 6, 2024 Best Way Disposal will begin servicing your area utilizing an automated collection system. Automated truck collection is more efficient than standard rear load collection. Increasing efficiency helps keep your cost down and keeping the driver in the truck is the single most important factor in order to increase productivity. Automated trucks utilize a mechanical arm which will wrap around the trash cart we have provided you and empty the contents into the top of the truck. Our carts are designed to work with this



collection system. Please do not purchase containers at a local store and expect them to hold up for an extended period of time. If you would like a second cart, please contact: Best Way at 1-800-745-5714

BASIC PROCEDURES:



- All trash must be bagged & placed inside the best way trash cart
- **2.** Place your cart within 4 feet of the roadway the night before your scheduled pick up day.
- 3. Make sure at least 3 FEET of CLEARANCE between your cart and any other object (ex: mailboxes, poles, trees, vehicles, guard wires, other carts)
- **4.** Please do not overload your cart. Loose trash on top of a cart will always end up on the ground as it falls down the side of the truck while being emptied.
- **5.** Place the cart at the curb with the arrows on the lid pointing to the street. Should your cart not have arrows, the wheels should be away from the street. This will prohibit damage to your lid as well as leave your lid shut after emptying.

PLACE THE NIGHT BEFORE

ONLY BAGGED TRASH

Have your curb cart out the night before; even if your Best Way Disposal driver is usually at your house later, there may be special circumstances that cause our routes to be rearranged on a particular day.

In order to minimize the potential for blowing litter in the neighborhoods we service, Best Way Disposal asks customers to place only bagged trash in their carts. This also helps reduce problems caused by messes or smells in your cart.



PLACING YOUR CARTS

Make sure trash cart is within 4 feet of the road, and 3 feet away from any obstructions (i.e, parked cars, fences, mailboxes, trees, etc...).



WHEELS TO THE BACK, LID CLOSED AND FACING STREET

Place carts with wheels facing away from the street and lid opening facing the street. Make sure the handle on the curb cart is facing towards your house, and away from the street.
