After temporarily experiencing limited food pantry operations due to some necessary maintenance, our food pantry is back online! Clients can now use our newly improved online ordering system to choose the items they would like to receive and schedule a date/time to pick up.

The new online system can be accessed by going to portal.soxbox.co/pantry/delaware-township-pantry or by going to the 'Food Pantry Assistance' page on our website and clicking the 'Access the Pantry' link.

The Delaware Township Food Pantry is available to those that live in HSE School District. On first visit, you will be asked to fill out an application and provide ID and proof of address. You can do this online or in our office during regular food pantry hours (M, T, T, F; 9-2).
